

Registration Instructions for the Winchester and Portsmouth Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers AGM Zoom Webinar

To attend the AGM, you will need to pre-register so that we know in advance who will be there.

You can register from **Saturday 12th September** onwards using the link provided via your District/Tower secretary or on Win-Port email, Facebook and Twitter.

When you click on the link above you will be presented with a form to fill in (fields marked with a red asterisk are mandatory).

If you are intending to join via phone only, please use the field provided to supply the telephone number from which you will be calling. This will help us identify you in the meeting.

If there will be more than one person attending via a single connection, please provide the names of the additional attendees in the field provided. Please do not fill in separate registrations for each person.

Once you have filled out the appropriate fields, click the 'Register' button. When your registration has been approved you will receive an email containing a link to join the webinar. Please do not delete the email as you will not be able to join the meeting without using the personalised link included. You will also be sent separately further instructions for joining and participating in the meeting.

W&P AGM Webinar – Basic Connectivity and Known Limitations

There are two ways to connect to the Webinar, those being via the Zoom Client on any device (PC, Mac, tablet, mobile phone) and the other via a good old telephone line (voice only). Given that a lot of communication in the current climate is done via video conference, it is quite likely that you already have the Zoom client installed. If not, in 99% of cases it will be automatically installed for you when you click on the meeting link you receive after your registration is approved. The only known exception so far is for Windows 10 users with S Mode turned on. We are not able to overcome this issue without S Mode being turned off. If you find this affects you, you can either turn off S Mode, or use a different device, or as a last resort, the telephone option. Turning off S Mode on your computer cannot be reversed.

It is not possible to connect to the meeting via just the browser interface, this is a Zoom restriction which cannot be circumvented, so to join the Webinar on a computer you will need the Zoom client application.

The joining instructions issued after your registration is approved will include details on what you should expect on the day, how to vote on items, and how to ask questions.
